

Senator Marco MINNITI
Minister of the Interior of the Republic of Italy

Domenico Minniti, also known as Marco Minniti, a graduate in Philosophy, married with two daughters, was born on 6th June, 1956 in Reggio Calabria (Italy).

Member of Parliament in the XIV, XV and XVI Legislature, was elected Senator in the XVII Legislature.

He was Founder and Chair of the Intelligence, Culture and Strategic Analysis Foundation (ICSA), the centre of analysis and cultural development that deals with issues related to security, defence and intelligence. Sen. Minniti left it in 2013 to take up the post of Secretary to the Prime Minister's Office – an Authority responsible for the security of the Country.

Prior to becoming Minister of the Interior on 12th December, 2016, he had been Secretary of State to the Prime Minister in the first D'Alema government, Minister of State at the Prime Minister's Office responsible for Intelligence services in the second D'Alema government, coordinator of the inter-ministerial Committee for the reconstruction of the Balkan region at the time of the crisis in Kosovo, Secretary of State for Defence in the second Amato government, Vice Minister of the Interior in the second Prodi government, and Undersecretary of State to the Prime Minister - Authority responsible for the security of the Country in the Letta and Renzi's Cabinets.
